During morning and afternoon chapel, Mrs. Rivers has started to lead the students in a new devotional – *Big Beliefs: Introducing Your Family to Big Truths*. Based on “The Westminster Confession of Faith,” this devotional explains the big doctrinal ideas of Christianity. The first lesson was about Scripture and its centrality to understanding God.

### **The Holy Scripture: The Record of Revelation**

*That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we looked upon and have touched with our hands, concerning the word of life— 2 the life was made manifest, and we have seen it, and testify to it and proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and was made manifest to us— 3 that which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you too may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ. 4 And we are writing these things so that our joy may be complete. - 1 John 1:1-4*

Abraham Lincoln was one of the greatest presidents our nation has ever known. How much do you know about this man? Where was he born? Was he short or tall? Did he have a wife and children? What was one of the greatest things he accomplished as president? How did he die? Did you ever meet Abraham Lincoln? Do you know anyone who ever met or saw him? The answer to these last two questions is no, because President Lincoln died more than 150 years ago. The only way we can know anything about him is because people who knew him and saw him recorded what they heard and saw in books and other written records. The same thing is true if you want to know about God. In the Bible, you can read about all the things that God did for his people thousands of years ago. As we begin our study through *Big Beliefs!*, remember: the Bible is the only way we can learn about God, ourselves, and God’s plan of salvation.
